For clubs who have completed their 2009 SAT, please view the [How to Guide](#) for assistance. Ensure to adhere to the policies regarding the issuing of tax receipts as Swim Ontario must abide by a stringent set of guidelines. Any of the funds that are collected cannot be disbursed or credited to an individuals account in any shape or form – funds raised must benefit of the entire club. Tax receipts are eligible for donations over \$10. If you club has a mandatory pre-set fundraising commitment, please ensure that any tax receipt requested by a parent is above the pre-set amount as set by the club. Please remember to forward a copy of club fee structure, all pledge sheets with a signed family affidavit attached, a signed club affidavit, the printed GraspIt report along with an undated cheque. Gold Bonus

Gold bonus calculations are now done electronically and shown as 'Post Meet Report' as seen on the SNC site once results have been uploaded. If there should there be any changes to your results or additional uploads, this will affect the total owing on your gold bonus – owed money will be posted on the Swim Ontario 'Accounts Receivables' site. It is the clubs responsibility to ensure that the correct amount has been submitted and to review the receivables site on a regular basis to ensure their club has no outstanding items.
