New Registration System

Hopefully Club Registrars have had the opportunity to try out the new registration system. Please be patient as we work through the challenges ahead. Swimming/Natation Canada has recently informed Swim Ontario that swimmer contact information was not transferred over to the new system from SwimDirect. Club Registrars are requested to begin setting up all member families with accounts so they can enter their swimmer contact information. Due to the need to evaluate statistics and to have accurate residential contact information, Swim Ontario requests families to enter the address which the swimmer resides at – ie. not a PO Box or school address. Once you have completed uploading your results to SNC, and are still in the completed meets view, if you click on the post meet report icon, you will see that a gold bonus invoice has been created for you from the result postings you have provided. All you need to do is print that report and submit it along with your gold bonus cheque to Swim Ontario. However, for any of your approved meets, you must still submit your calculations on a hard copy of the gold bonus report form and submit that along with your cheque to Swim Ontario.
